#### Materials:

- A large piece of paper or posterboard, in any color
- A long stick or ruler
- Markers
- Tape (masking tape works best)
- Ribbon stencil (pg. 2)
- Scissors

#### **Instructions:**

- 1. Take your paper or posterboard and write your message. Use as many colors as you like make your sign your own! Examples are on page 3.
- 2. Take your board and tape it to the front of your stick or ruler.
- 3. Decorate your ribbon (pg. 2).
- 4. Cut out your ribbon.
- 5. Tape the ribbon to your shirt and wear it proudly.
- 6. Now you're ready to march!
